POSTEMERGENCE APPLICATIONS OF 0.5 OUNCE PER ACRE ON SOILS CONSISTING OF THE CLARION-NICOLLET-WEBSTER ASSOCIATION IN IOWA

One-half ounce per acre of Du Pont "Classic" Herbicide - either alone or in tank-mix combinations with other herbicides listed on the "Classic" label - may be applied postemergence to soybeans growing in soils of the Clarion-Nicollet-Webster Association in Iowa. Soils in this series are located in the counties of Boone, Buena Vista, Calhoun, Carroll, Cerro Gordo, Clay, Dallas, Dickinson, Emmett, Floyd, Franklin, Greene, Guthrie, Hamilton, Hancock, Hardin, Humbolt, Jasper, Kossuth, Marshall, Mitchell, Osceola, Palo Alto, Pocahontas, Polk, Sac, Story, Webster, Winnebago, Wright, and Worth in Iowa.

Selection of a treatment is dependent upon the weeds present in the field. Examine the WEEDS CONTROLLED section of the "Classic" label to determine which herbicide treatment to use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use "Classic" in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply "Classic" through any type of irrigation system.

One-half ounce of "Classic" herbicide must be applied before July 15 to soybeans growing in well-drained, high-fertility soils of 3 percent or greater organic matter and pH of 7.5 or less.

Refer to the "Classic" label for specific spray parameters.

The total amount of "Classic" cannot exceed 0.5 ounce per acre in a single growing season.

ROTATIONAL CROPPING RESTRICTIONS

Soybeans may be planted anytime. Cereal grains may be planted 3 months after an application. Field corn may be planted 9 months after an application. The term "field corn" is defined to include only that corn grown for grain or silage. For crops other than soybeans, cereal grains, and field corn, add 10 additional months to the recrop interval listed on the "Classic" recrop label.
