

Du Pont "Escort" Herbicide applied in tank-mix combination with Du Pont "Krenite" S Herbicide is recommended for improved control of brush species including; black cherry and red maple in non-crop areas.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Applications should be made during the period from July to first fall coloration. For high volume ground equipment, mix 1 1/2 to 3 gallons of "Krenite" S per 100 gallons of water in the spray tank with the agitator running. Do not prepare less than a 1 1/2% solution or exceed 6 gallons "Krenite" S per acre. Add 1/2 to 1 ounce of "Escort" per 100 gallons to spray tank. Continuous agitation is required to keep products in suspension. Apply a quantity of spray solution which will thoroughly and uniformly cover the target brush without causing unnecessary run-off. Total rate and volume per acre will depend on plant species, height and density of growth, and on type of equipment used. On tall brush, it is often necessary to spray from both sides to obtain adequate coverage.

NOTE: Application of "Krenite" S + "Escort" will result in brownout of existing treated foliage approximately 1 to 3 weeks after spraying.

Do not apply to any body of water, including streams, irrigation water, or wells. Do not apply during periods of intense rainfall or to water-saturated soils, or to frozen ground as off-target movement may occur. Do not apply where runoff water may flow onto agricultural land, as injury to crops may result.

Do not apply "Escort" during periods of intense rainfall, or to water saturated soils, or to frozen ground as off-target movement may occur.

This bulletin contains new or supplemental instructions for use of these products which may not appear on the package labels. Follow the instructions carefully.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
