- Delete reference to "other similar areas" as this may allow for domestic uses that would require further data to support.
- Define and clarify when to use the range of doses claimed under "Directions For Use". What weeds are controlled preemergence and postemergence at the different doses (2.5 to 6.0 lbs product)? The user of this product must know what to expect.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA, Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
