DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Du Pont "Velpar" ULW Herbicide is recommended to be applied as a granular (dry) by aerial application for control of weeds and brush (see container label) at the Eglin Air Force Base including bomb or missile ranges and reforestation areas.

HOW TO USE

Apply at rates of 2 1/3 to 8 lbs. "Velpar" ULW per acre as shown on the container label for "Forestry Site Preparation" to control brush species listed. Treatment will also control the following weeds:

Lower rates will provide short-term control.

Apply the granules using Du Pont ULW Applicator aerial equipment. Calibrate the equipment to distribute the granules uniformly over the area to be treated. Wear gloves when handling granules to prevent contact with skin. Apply before or during the period of active growth, when rainfall can be expected to activate the chemical in the soil. Do not apply to water saturated soils when rainfall is expected within 24 hours. Distribution across treatment swath must be uniform.
