Dear Ms. Mullin:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Change the heading "Statement of Practical Treatment" to "First Aid".
- 2. EPA has issued PR Notice 2000-3 revising first aid statements. The following are revised statements that are required for products placed in toxicity category III and above. Please revise your label accordingly.

"IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice".

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

| 7505C | SPROAT | 12/14/00 | IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center for treatment advice.

- 3. Add the following statement to your "First Aid" section: "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment"
- 4. Please revise the "Precautionary Statements section of your label to read "May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while holding evelids open. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN; Wash with soap and water immediately. After drying apply Vitamin E cream or oil (these can be purchased at most pharmacies, drug stores, and supermarkets). If Vitamin E cream or oil is not immediately available, apply any vegetable oil liberally over any painful areas. The oil or cream (vegetable or Vitamin E) may be used repeatedly until relief is achieved. Symptoms will often disappear over several hours and, with Vitamin E oil or cream, sometimes relief comes within minutes. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and provide oxygen if breathing is difficult. Get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Do not give liquids if victim is unconscious or very drowsy. Otherwise, give no more than 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by giving 30 cc (2 tablespoons) syrup of Ipecac*. If Ipecac is unavailable, give 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of victim's throat. Keep victim's head below hips while vomiting. Get medical attention.
