Dear Ms. Ashley:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you do the following:


1. Submit a Guideline 870.7800: Immunotoxicity Study for triflusulfuron-methyl within **two (2) years** from the date of this notice.
2. Submit the following ecological effects studies for triflusulfuron-methyl within **one (1) year** from the date of this notice:
 - a. Guideline 850.1075: Freshwater Fish Toxicity
 - b. Guideline 850.1010: Acute Toxicity to Freshwater Invertebrates
 - c. Guideline 850.1300: Chronic Toxicity to Freshwater Invertebrates
 - d. Guideline 850.1400: Freshwater Fish Early-Life Stage
 - e. Guideline 850.4150: Tier II Vegetative Vigor
3. Submit the following environmental fate studies for triflusulfuron-methyl within **two (2) years** from the date of this notice:
 - a. Guideline 835.4100: Aerobic Soil Metabolism
 - b. Guideline 835.4200: Anaerobic Soil Metabolism
 - c. Guideline 835.4300: Aerobic Aquatic Metabolism
 - d. Guideline 835.4400: Anaerobic Aquatic Metabolism
 - e. Environmental Chemistry Methods (ECMs) and Independent Laboratory Validations (ILVs) for the analysis of triflusulfuron-methyl residues in water

4. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/registration review of your product when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit data.
5. Note that for future new uses, DuPont must clarify which enforcement method will be used (AMR 1930-91 or Method 4480). If Method 4480 is to be used for enforcement purposes, standards must be made available to the USEPA's Analytical Chemistry Branch (ACB) in the event that they differ from those used in method AMR 1930-91.

A stamped copy of your label is enclosed for your records. This label supersedes all previously accepted labels. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Products shipped after eighteen (18) months from the date of this letter or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA §6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
