The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. Under the "Directions for Use" section, change the heading "Terrestrial Nonfood Crops" to "Terrestrial Nonfood". Additionally, revise the listing appearing after this heading to read as, "golf course turf and landscape ornamentals, noncrop/nongrazed areas."
- 2. Based on the 6(a)(2) information contained in the October 2005 study, "Magnitude of DPX-KN128 and IN-KN127 Residues in Cotton Gin Trash Following Application of DPX-KN128 150EC Experimental Insecticide or DPX-MP062 150SC Insecticide—2004 USA" (MRID 466845-01) the reported residues of EPA Reg. No. 352-598 exceed the current tolerance for cotton gin byproducts. Therefore, due to the current risk cup issues with indoxacarb and the inability to increase existing tolerances, you must delete cotton from the technical label and submit a revised label for the end use product, EPA Reg. No. 352-598, reflecting this deletion within thirty days of this letter.
