The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended to add new uses for grapes, hops and caneberries is acceptable provided that you.

1. Make the following changes to the label.


a. In the First Aid section, If Inhaled, second line, "mouth to moth" should be changed to read "mouth to mouth".

b. In the Storage and Disposal section, the subheading "Storage" should be changed to "Pesticide Storage".
