The scientific review and evaluation of the revised basic confidential statement of formula (CSF) submitted above have been completed. The basic CSF dated March 8, 2006 is acceptable provided a 5-batch analysis is submitted once the manufacturing facility is in full production. This CSF supersedes all previously approved ones. Our records have been modified accordingly.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

1. In your Storage and Disposal section revise "Storage" to read "Pesticide Storage" and revise "Product Disposal" to read "**Pesticide Disposal**"
2. In your Notice of Warranty, revise the fourth sentence to read "**To the fullest extent permitted by law**, all such risks shall be assumed by the buyer."

Submit one copy of your final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.
