The proposed labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable with the following comments:

- Under the "Notice of Warranty" section, revise the last sentence so it reads, "To the extent consistent with applicable law, Dupont makes no warranties..."
- In the "Container Handling" section, delete the sentence "Refer to the Net Contents section of this product's labeling for the applicable "Nonrefillable Container" or "Refillable Container" designation." The final printed label must bear only the instructions for the appropriate container type.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on <u>non-refillable</u> containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself. This information can be added by non-notification per PR Notice 98-10.
