

- c. Delete the following claims that appear on the label:
 - i. Delete all quick kill claims, e.g., "Fire ants find/pick up bait in minutes", (As per the 6/30/2005 efficacy review, no efficacy data were submitted to support claims that the product kills fire ants prior to 72 hours.)
 - ii. Delete the claim "exclusive formula". Non-specific words without valid comparison are not allowed.
 - iii. In the statement: "Use straight from the Bag (Bottle, Container)", "from" is spelled incorrectly.
 - d. The claim: "New! Measure and Pour Applicator Cap" may be used for a period of 6 months from the date of the Label approval.
 - e. In the box titled: "FOR BEST RESULTS", delete "FOR BEST RESULTS" because this implies that it is optional language.
 - f. Under the "phone/computer i-con" statements:
 - i. The National Pesticide Information Center (NPIC) phone number (1-800-858-7378) is an optional service available for information and emergency advice.
 - g. Revise the WARRANTY DISCLAIMER and INHERENT RISKS OF USE language as follows, respectively:
 - i. In front of the second sentence, add: "To the extent consistent with applicable law, Seller makes no express nor implied..."
 - ii. Change the last sentence to read: "To the extent consistent with applicable law, all such risks shall be assumed by the Buyer."
3. Product Chemistry data requirements for the 830 Series Subgroup A and Subgroup B guidelines are satisfied, except for the one year storage stability and the corrosion characteristic studies. Storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) data are outstanding and must be submitted to satisfy the requirements of 40CFR 158.190 within 18 months from the date of this Notice.
4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
