The application referred to above, submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable under FIFRA §3(c)(7)(B) subject to the following conditions:

1. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration review of your product when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data. Data requirements for glyphosate are outlined in GDCI-417300-886 under docket ID EPA-HQ-OPP-2009-0361 at [www.regulations.gov](http://www.regulations.gov).
2. The supplemental labeling must be incorporated into the main product labeling within eighteen (18) months from the date of this letter.

A stamped copy of the supplemental label is enclosed for your records. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Products released for shipment after eighteen (18) months from the date of this letter must bear the new revised label.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA §6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use this product until you have read the entire label.

Apply DuPont DPX-B2856 3.0 herbicide to canola containing the OPTIMUM® GLY herbicide tolerance trait. Application of this product to canola that does not contain the OPTIMUM® GLY trait will result in severe crop injury and yield loss.

Applications to OPTIMUM® GLY Canola

- Apply DPX-B2856 3.0 up to a rate of 64 fl oz/A as a preplant or preemergence broadcast spray made with ground or aerial equipment. The combined total rate, per crop season, for all applications must not exceed 64 fl oz/A.
- A single postemergence application of DPX-B2856 3.0 must be made at a rate of 14 to 24 fl oz/A postemergence from crop emergence until the 6-leaf stage. Do not make applications later than the 6-leaf stage or during crop bolting or flowering, as crop injury and yield loss may result. Avoid spray overlaps which may result in temporary yellowing of the canola, delayed flowering, or growth reduction. Similar symptoms may occur if rates above 14 fl oz/A are applied after the 4-leaf stage of the canola.
- Split (sequential) postemergence applications may be made by spraying 16 fl oz/A at the 1 to 3 leaf stage of OPTIMUM® GLY canola, followed by a second application of 16 fl oz/A after a minimum of 10 days. The second application must not be sprayed later than the 6-leaf stage. Do not make more than two postemergence applications from crop emergence up until the 6-leaf stage of the crop.

Restrictions for Use on OPTIMUM® GLY Canola

- Refer to the Section 3 Federal product label for listings of other labeled crops, weeds controlled, application information, and other important precautions and restrictions.
- Employ a 30-day plantback interval for all non-labeled crops following applications of DPX-B2856 3.0 to Optimum GLY canola.
