Side Panel: directions: Wasps are divided into groups (HORNETS, Yellow
 Jackets, Mud Daubers, Polistes, Cicada Killers). The round
 papier-mache, single hole nests are made by Hornets and
 Yellow Jackets--open nests of mud or clay are Mud Daubers.
 Cicada Killers build in or on the ground. Most Wasps kill
 destructive insects and are beneficial. When wasps build
 nests under eaves, flower boxes or too close to houses
 where children play, they should be destroyed.

How To Spray: For short distance, press nozzle lightly on
 for long distance (over 10 ft.) press nozzle all the way
 down.
 When To Spray: Individual wasps may be killed by hitting
 them with a direct spray. Nests should be sprayed at night
 when the wasps are less active and most of them are in their
 nests. Spray a steady stream at the nest, concentrating at
 the opening. Spray screens, window frames, rafters and other
 places where wasps crawl. Do not spray flowers or shrubs.
 For outdoor use only, do not use indoors.
 First Aid: If stung by a wasp, apply an ice pack to
 the area of the sting, then apply a paste made with bicar-
 bonate of soda and water. If stung many times or if the
 reaction is severe, call a physician.
