INFORMATION: A highly effective repellent for rabbits and meadow mice. An effective repellent for deer. One application will protect trees, especially deciduous dormant apple trees from animal damage for the entire winter. May be painted or sprayed. Will not chip, peel or wash away during the stormiest winter weather. Will not injure trees or foliage — nor will it injure any animal.

DIRECTIONS:

RABBITS and MICE — It is most important to cover every part of the tree trunk that may be reached by rabbits or mice. Allow for extra high damage from snow levels. Paint or spray so that no part of the tree treatment area is left uncovered. The repellent must dry completely the day it is applied. Treat between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. on a good, clear drying day. Also spray low hanging branches that may be reached.

DEER — Spray tree trunks and foliage. Varieties known to be favored by deer. These will vary in some areas and may include dormant apple trees and other fruit trees. Some varieties of evergreens, including taxus.

NOTE — Chew-Not is green in color, permitting use on conifers without objectionable residue. Inspect green coating the day following treatment and reapply to all areas not completely covered.
