

## THEIR LAST MEAL

GOPHERS - Burrowing pocket gophers throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral openings are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a long handled spoon carefully remove the plug. Introduce two tablespoons of MOLOGEN as far into the tunnel as possible. Reclose opening.

MOLES - The presence of moles is indicated either by a network of ridges in the turf or (when burrowing deeply) by a series of conical mounds of earth pushed up from below.

SURFACE RIDGES: To locate active runways crosh the mores at frequent intervals and return next day to find some of the tunnels reconstructed. Carefully punch a hole in the tor of the active tunnels drop in two tablespoons of MOLOGEN and carefully close the hole. Take care not to again collapse the tunnel or allow loose soil to cover the bait.

DEEP LUNNELS. Remove center plug from the conical mounds with the aid of a long handled spoon and drop two tablespoons of MOLOGEN into the underground tunnel. Close opening with rock or sod.
