**DANGER:** Convulsive poison! Do not contaminate feed and feedstuffs. Keep away from children and domestic animals.

**ANTIDOTE:** If less than 10 minutes has passed since the poison was taken, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water. Have victim lie down in a quiet, darkened room and keep him warm. Call a physician immediately.

Side Panel:

**Gophers** - Burrowing pocket gophers throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral openings are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a long handled spoon carefully remove the plug. Introduce two tablespoons of Super Mole-Nots as far into the tunnel as possible. reclose opening.

**Moles** - The presence of moles is indicated either by a network of ridges in the turf or (when burrowing deeply) by a series of conical mounds of earth pushed up from below.

**Surface Ridges:** To locate active runways crush the ridges at frequent intervals and return next day to find some of the tunnels reconstructed. Carefully punch a hole in the top of the active tunnels, drop in two tablespoons of Super Mole-Nots and carefully close the hole. Take care not to again collapse the tunnel or allow loose soil to cover the bait.

**Deep Tunnels:** Remove soil plug from the conical mound with the aid of a long handled spoon and drop two table-
