The revised labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable, providing you make the changes specified below.

1. In compliance with PR Notice 91-7, delete the word "SPECIAL" from the labeling. EPA does not presently allow any unquantified claims that imply heightened efficacy, as does the word "special".
2. The subheading "Specific directions for pocket gophers." should be set in bold type as on the previous label.

Submit one copy of final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

We approve your plan to sticker over the "Statement of Practical Treatment" on your existing inventory before you release the product for shipment. Note that you are still required to submit a copy of the "informational bulletin" that you must provide your distributors, as well as a list of those distributors. The Zinc Phosphide Consortium has informed you of those requirements.

This registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e) if you do not comply with these conditions. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Specific directions for pocket gophers. Burrowing pocket gophers (*Thomomys* spp. and *Geomys* spp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a long-handled spoon carefully remove the plug. Insert a teaspoonful amount as far down as possible. Reclose opening, being careful not to cover bait with soil.

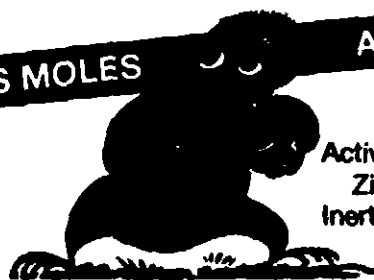
