Purpose The purpose of these submissions is to revise your labeling according to PR
Notices 2001-1 and 2001-6 and to make other labeling changes.

Label The Agency last accepted a label for this product on August 11, 1993, over 10
years ago. The labeling submitted with the above letter, is acceptable, provided
you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following
changes, before you ship your product.

1. Align "Active" and "Inert" to the same left margin.
2. Since the signal word for this product is "CAUTION", the text should
begin as "May be harmful if swallowed ..."
3. Add the following required text for zinc phosphide products immediately
under "FIRST AID":

Any persons applying zinc phosphide products and experiencing signs
and symptoms such as nausea, abdominal pain, tightness in the chest,
or weakness, should be seen by a physician immediately.



ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS
This product is toxic to wildlife and fish. Birds and other wildlife feeding on treated bait may be killed. Do not apply bait to be exposed on soil surface. Pick up and properly dispose of all spilled toxic bait. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds and all aquatic systems. Do not apply where run-off from this product will enter an aquatic system.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Restrictions. For use against moles and pocket gophers in lawns, golf courses, and other non-crop areas. Do not apply in gardens and areas where food or feed may be contaminated. Only apply the bait underground and by hand. Collect and bury all dead animals found above ground.

Specific directions for moles. The presence of moles may be indicated by a network of surface ridges in the turf, by a series of conical mounds of earth pushed up from deep burrows, or by damage to bulbs.

Surface ridges. Prior to treatment, determine which burrows are active according to one of the following two methods. Either press down a small section of the tunnel or remove a one inch section of the tunnel's roof. Mark these sections and recheck in 24 hours. The burrow is considered active if the flattened runway has been raised up or if the roof has been repaired. Only treat active burrows. Carefully punch a hole in the top of active tunnels, drop in a teaspoonful and carefully close the hole with sod or stone. Do not collapse the runway again or allow loose soil to cover the bait. After a few days check to see if the burrows are still active according to one of the two methods described above. If so, repeat treatment.

Conical Mounds. Remove center plug from the conical mounds with the aid of a long-handled spoon and drop a teaspoonful of MOLE-NOTS into the underground tunnel. Close opening with sod or stone. Do not allow loose dirt to cover bait.

Specific directions for pocket gophers. Burrowing pocket gophers (*Thomomys* spp. and *Geomys* spp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a long-handled spoon carefully remove the plug. Insert a teaspoonful of MOLE-NOTS as far down as possible. Reclose opening, being careful not to cover bait with soil.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep product in tightly closed original container. Store in a dry area not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or wildlife. Do not store near material with a strong odor.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.

Never place used product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
