

A SODIUM ARSENITE SOLUTION

(Contains 6 Pounds of As2O3 per Gallon)

ACTIVE INGREDIENT:

Sodium arsenite (NaH₂AsO₃)₂ • HAsO₂

INERT INGREDIENTS

Arsenic in water soluble form expressed as metallic 31.96%

Contains 6 lbs. arsenic trioxide (As₂O₃) per gal. at 68 F.

Do not store at temperatures below 32 F.



POISON-DANGER



ANTIDOTE: Give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Then give two tablespoonfuls of Epsom Salts or Milk of Magnesia in water, and plenty of milk and water. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY!

DANGER: Poisonous if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid breathing spray mist. Keep animals and children off treated areas.

Do not use or store in or around the home.

Do not allow domestic animals to graze treated areas.

DANGER: Use only according to directions. Keep chemical, empty drums and diluted spray away from unauthorized people, children and animals. Goggles should be worn by spray operators. If splashed in eyes, flush out thoroughly with water and bathe with boric acid solution. SEE A DOCTOR. In case of skin contact, wash off immediately. If skin rash or festers develop from unsuspected contact, apply Milk of Magnesia to affected skin areas after washing thoroughly; repeat application as needed. See a Doctor. Wash contaminated clothing with hot soapy water before re-use. Do not contaminate feeds and foodstuffs. Wash and rinse empty drums thoroughly with plenty of clean water. Do not re-use empty containers in any connection with feed, food or drinking water. Do not use where there is danger of the chemical being absorbed by roots of desirable plants, trees and ornamentals growing nearby. Keep spray and rinse water off all vegetation not to be killed.

This product is toxic to wildlife. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Dispose of rinse water where it will not be a hazard to burrows, animals or wildlife.

Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes. Dispose of rinse water where it will not be a hazard to humans. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NON-SELECTIVE WEED CONTROL: Annual Weeds and Grasses - For treatment of bare ground and small enclosed industrial areas such as tank farms and substations, use 1 pint of Atlas "A" 6 mixed with 2½ gallons of water; apply with sprayer to cover 750 square feet of area. For weed control in enclosed industrial areas, use the same rate wetting all leaves, stems, and root crowns.

Do not use around the home or on or near desirable plants.

Avoid spray drift to desirable plants. Do not use more than 8 ½ gallons (50 pounds arsenic trioxide equivalent) per acre.

Follow directions carefully. Timing and method of application, weather and crop conditions, mixtures with other chemicals not specifically recommended, and other influencing factors in the use of this product are beyond the control of the seller. Buyer assumes all risks of use, storage or handling of this material not in strict accordance with directions given herewith.
