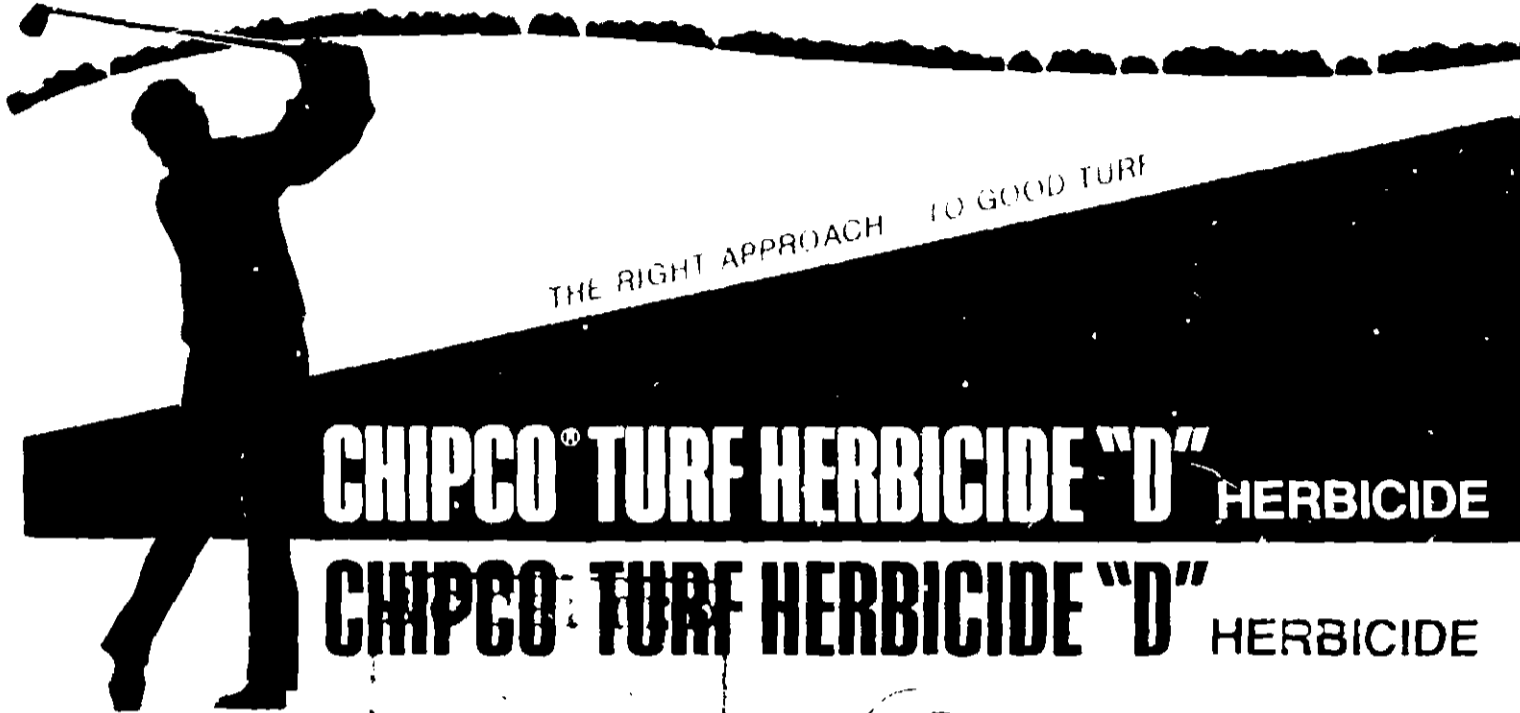

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from target area. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, feed, seeds, fertilizers, insecticides, or fungicides by transport, storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not store near other pesticides or seeds. Do not reuse containers. Store at temperatures above 32 F. If allowed to freeze, remix before using.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide spray mixture or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of in approved landfill or bury in a safe place. Consult Federal, State or Local Disposal Authorities for approved alternative procedures.

GENERAL INFORMATION

NOTE: Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure tomatoes, beans, peas, other vegetables, legumes, and ornamentals. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift than the fine mist sprays. Do not use same spray equipment for other purposes if traces of this product in such equipment are likely to be harmful to sprayed vegetation. Avoid spillage. Avoid contamination of water intended for irrigation and domestic use. Store at temperatures above 32 F. If allowed to freeze, remix before using.

Do not use on lawns and greenhouses.

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TURF WEED CONTROL

HOW TO USE:

Use 11-12 quarts per acre or 1-1.5 ounces in 1/2 gals. water per 1,000 sq. ft. or 20 to 40 gallons of water for uniform coverage. Repeat applications may be necessary. Use lower rate for easy-to-kill species marked * See list. Use higher rate for more effective control of other weeds.

WHEN TO USE:

Use preferably in the spring or fall when weeds are actively growing. The chemical action is more rapid when applied on warm, clear, sunny days than when weather is cool, cloudy, or wet.

Note: Do not use on newly seeded lawn. Do not mow turf for several days before or after treatment. White Clover may be injured by a light treatment but recovers; repeated treatments will kill it. In some areas, Dichondra, Bentgrass, Carpetgrass, Buffalo grass, and St. August begonia may be injured. Usually the Colonial Bents are more tolerant than the creeping types, and the white clovers are most easily injured.

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
