For initial Application in Southern areas with long growing season, apply 400 to 800 lbs. per acre (1 to 2 lbs. per 100 sq. ft.). In Northern areas with shorter growing season, apply 200 to 800 lbs. per acre (½ to 2 lbs. per 100 sq. ft.).

For Follow Up Treatments: Northern and Southern areas - apply 200 to 600 lbs. per acre (1/2 to 11/2 lb. per 100 sq. ft.)

The amount to use will depend on the type of weeds present, the degree of control and duration of effect required. These depend on soil type, tainfall and other conditions.

NOTE: Borea K-10 should be used wherever annual rainfall is in excess of 30 inches

WHEN TO APPLY: May be applied at any time of year, except when ground is frozen, as long as adequate moisture is supplied, either by rainfall or irrigation. Best results are obtained on annual and perennial weeds in high rainfall areas when applied just before weed growth begins. To avoid fire hazard from dead and dry vegetation, apply when weeds and grass are small.
