WARNING

Poisonous if Swallowed, Inhaled, or Absorbed Through Skin! Rapidly absorbed through skin! Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear protective clothing, natural rubber gloves and goggles. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, shrimp, crabs, and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not store below 32°F. Keep from heat and open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
