Your Submission of November 12, 1984

The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA are acceptable, provided you:

1. Make the following changes in labeling prior to releasing the products for shipment:
  - a. For 359-491, add the following statements:

(Environmental Hazards) "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes;" (Pesticide Disposal)  
"Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according

to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance." Also, the statement making reference to "contamination of water...for irrigation..." is more appropriately grouped with other environmental hazard statements.

b. For 359-534, add the appropriate environmental hazards statements and delete reentry statements. We do not consider this use on peas subject to PR Notice 81-2.

c. For 359-548, add the following statements:

(Environmental Hazards) "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes;" (Pesticide Disposal) "Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance."

d. For 359-634 and 359-656, the appropriate front panel language is as follows: (1) "For Formulating Herbicides Only;" (2) "Precautionary Statements" heading, "Hazards to Humans" and "Environmental Hazards" subheadings; (3) "Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance contact your regional office of the EPA;" (4) "Caution" and "Keep Out of Reach of Children" may not be conjoined, i.e., each phrase must be positioned so that it stands alone.

e. (No changes required for 359-539 and 359-680).

2. Submit one copy of final printed labeling for those products where labeling changes are required.

A stamped copy of labeling for each product is enclosed for your records.

Please note that labeling for your sodiazon products was not reviewed with other labeling submitted. We are considering these revisions in the context of other evaluations in progress for this chemical.
