The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(A), are acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add a space between "of" and "Benzene" and add the closing parenthesis after Hexachloride in the ingredients statement, as requested in your Notice of Registration dated April 5, 1982.
2. Add "Repeat until vomit fluid is clear" after "...throat with finger" in the "If swallowed" advice.
3. Add "or convulsing" between "unconscious" and "person" in the last sentence of the "If swallowed" advice.
4. Add "Remove contaminated clothing" as the first sentence of the "If on skin" advice.
5. Revise the Pesticide Disposal text to read in total:

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

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6. Revise the Container Disposal text to read: Completely empty liner

by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of drum in the same manner.

7. The last sentence of the conditions of sale, etc., should be modified to read something like "from the misuse or improper handling of this product." Refer to the enclosed memorandum and Notice to Manufacturers concerning Warranties and Disclaimers.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The revised formula statement has been added to the product's registration file.
