Cleaning and deodorizing:

As an aid to cleaning and deodorizing for washing floors, woodwork, sinks, etc., add 4 ounces of Pine Type Disinfectant to a pail of water. For toilets, garbage cans, etc., use 1 part in 55 parts of water.

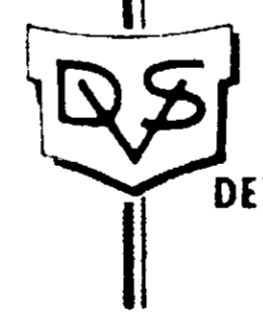
Disinfecting and deodorizing:

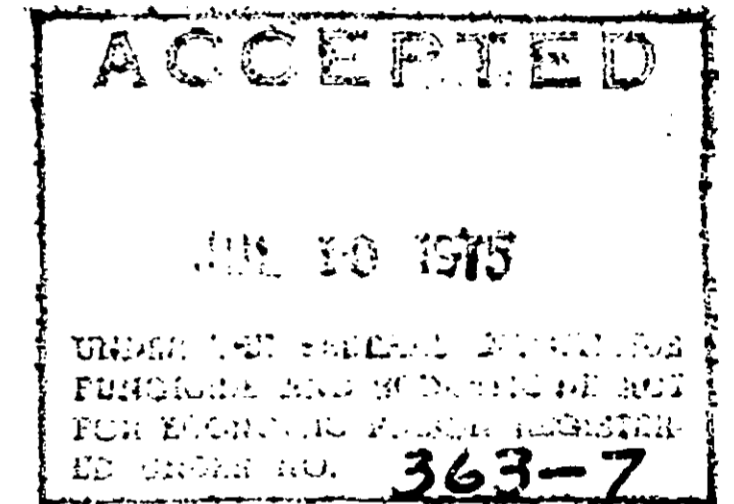

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

C-4 Zip phenolic Disinfectant is a powerful, highly concentrated, emulsifying disinfectant, and should be diluted with water as directed below.

For best results, use warm water. Cold or hard water retards the forming of an emulsion. Cold or hard water should be softened by the use of flake or stripped soap in proportion of 1 part of soap to 10 parts of water. Add flake or stripped soap in proper proportion after the soap is dissolved in water.

The use of soap in this disinfectant does not harm or reduce the killing power of the product.

GENERAL USE

Three to four tablespoons of disinfectant to one quart of warm water or one quart to about 30 quarts of warm water.

APPLICATION

Mop, scrub, spray, or sprinkle this solution liberally on surface to be treated.

FOR USE AS A DISINFECTANT IN LIVESTOCK BUILDINGS

Three to four quarts of disinfectant to one quart of water, follow the directions below.

1. Floors, walls, and ceilings of buildings should be treated with the disinfectant solution. Wash floors with water after treatment.

2. Disinfect all equipment, including feed troughs, water troughs, and milking machines, with the disinfectant solution.

3. Disinfect all bedding, including straw, hay, and shavings, with the disinfectant solution.

4. Disinfect all manure, including manure pits, with the disinfectant solution.

5. Disinfect all areas where animals are kept, including stalls, pens, and runs, with the disinfectant solution.

NOTICE: IMPORTANT. DO NOT USE IN MILK ROOMS, MILKING PARLORS, AND DAIRY BARN.

ENVIRONMENTAL CAUTIONS
