DIRECTIONS

Remove red cap. Cut off top to allow powder to puff out. The powder may be puffed along baseboard, wainscoting, shelves, cracks and crevices, wherever insects are observed. This is most conveniently done at night before retiring, as insects come for food at night. Repeat as often as necessary. For best results squeeze the powder puffer and puff powder back under cracks where powder cannot be seen, yet the pests are sure to come in contact with the killer. Place the dust only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Any powder visible after application is completed should be carefully brushed into cracks or crevices or else removed.
