

# DANGER!

HAZARDOUS LIQUID

for at least 15 minutes; for eyes, get  
medical attention.

Wash clothing before re-use.

**NOTE:** Speed in removing Phenol from pa-  
tient is of utmost importance.

When this container is empty, rinse out  
and discard immediately. Do not reuse.

## DIRECTIONS

For use as a general disinfectant on inani-  
mate objects (such as walls, floors, work  
surfaces, etc.) in hospitals and laboratories.  
Dilute to a 5% solution by adding about  
6½ ozs. to 1 gallon of water and apply  
with an ordinary insect spray gun until all  
surfaces are thoroughly wet.

## ANTIDOTE

**IF SWALLOWED,** if conscious, force patient  
to drink copious amounts of fluids such as  
milk or water; then induce vomiting by tick-  
ling the back of throat with finger or by  
giving an emetic such as two tablespoonfuls  
of table salt in a glass of warm water.  
Continue this procedure until vomit fluid is  
free of phenol odor.

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
