NOTE: To Liquefy, place container in water, heat to above 104°F., and then add 10% water. Store the liquefied phenol in amber glass bottles to avoid discoloration.

DIRECTIONS

For use as a general disinfectant on inanimate objects (such as walls, floors, work surfaces, etc.) in hospitals and laboratories. Dilute to a 5% solution by adding about 6½ ozs. to 1 gallon of water and apply with an ordinary insect spray gun until all surfaces are thoroughly wet.

CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY

ANTIDOTE:

IF SWALLOWED: if conscious, force patient to drink copious amounts of fluids such as milk or water; then induce vomiting by tickling the back of throat with finger or by giving an emetic such as two tablespoonfuls of table salt in a glass of warm water. Continue this procedure until vomit fluid is free of phenol odor.
