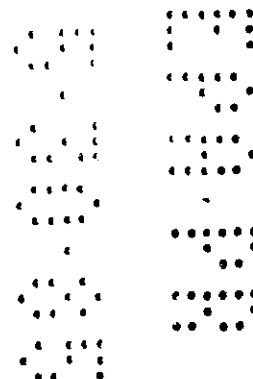

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. May cause irritation. Avoid breathing dust. **IN CASE OF CONTACT**, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. **GET MEDICAL ATTENTION** if irritation persists. Always wear protective clothing and respirator when mixing and applying pesticides. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep children and pets out of treated area during application.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages increases the toxic effects of thiram.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

THIS PRODUCT IS TOXIC TO FISH. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Drift or runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Keep away from fire or sparks.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL (U.S.A.) LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

Do not rotate treated crop with crops other than those with registered thiram uses.

Add recommended amount to a partially filled spray tank under agitation. Complete filling to the desired volume. Keep agitated to insure even suspension of material. Make fresh daily. Spray uniformly over the area with a boom-type or other power sprayer.

RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

Do not re-enter treated areas within 24 hours following application unless protective clothing is worn.

TURF

Apply after mowing or avoid mowing for 12 hours after application. Apply in sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage, usually 5 gal. per 1,000 sq. ft. of turf area. Always treat aprons and approaches to golf greens. Under conditions of severe disease, apply every 5 to 7 days. **Note to users:** Do not apply to areas likely to be grazed by livestock and do not feed clippings to livestock or poultry.

Use on golf course greens, tees, lawn and fairways of Bentgrasses, Bluegrasses, Fescues, Bermudagrasses, Ryegrasses, St. Augustine grass or their mixtures for the prevention and control of **DOLLAR SPOT** *Sclerotinia homoeocarpa*, **BROWN PATCH** *Rhizoctonia solani*, and **FUSARIUM PATCH** *Fusarium nivale*.

PREVENTIVE TREATMENT

To prevent dollar spot and brown patch use 2½ oz. of THIRAMAD® per 1,000 sq. ft. at seven day intervals throughout the warm season. It may be necessary to make more frequent applications when conditions are especially favorable for the development of disease.

For snow mold Apply 8 oz. of THIRAMAD® per 1,000 sq. ft. in the fall, just prior to snowfall.

CURATIVE TREATMENT

For dollar spot and large brown patch use 3 oz. of THIRAMAD® per 1,000 sq. ft. applied at 5 to 7 day intervals.

For best results do not water or mow grass for 24 hours after application.

Do not allow animals to feed or graze on treated areas. Do not use grass clippings from treated areas for food or feed purposes. Avoid spray drift to fish pools and ponds.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store at a temperature exceeding 122°F. (50°C.). Store in a dry place in a well-closed container. Do not allow to become wet or overheated in storage. This may cause chemical changes which will impair the fungicidal effectiveness of THIRAMAD® and may also generate flammable vapors.

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities.
