

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**FOR PROFESSIONAL USE ONLY**

TRUBAN is a soil fungicide for control of damping off, root and stem rot diseases caused by *Pythium* and *Phytophthora*. It may be used at time of seeding and transplanting as a drench for control of these problem fungi in greenhouses and outdoors.

TRUBAN suspensions in water should be cloudy and vigorously agitated. Wash for uniform application of material. TRUBAN suspensions need not be protected from light. Use at recommended rates. Overdosage may result in toxicity to sensitive parts of plants. If plants are suspected of being sensitive, apply fungicide to a small number to insure safety. TRUBAN should not be mixed with other pesticides or nutrients.

Thoroughly rinse TRUBAN residues from all equipment after use. Always use protective clothing and respirator when mixing and applying pesticides.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Not sensitive to light. Stable at normal temperatures and humidities.

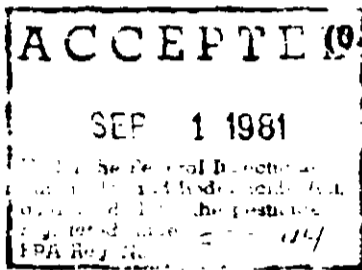
**PROMPTIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Repeat immediately with additional water. Wash half the volume of the fungicide drench for improved penetration of the fungicide. Repeat at 2 to 3 month intervals. Disease control.
<b>Container &amp; Bedgrown</b> Begonia Calceolary Chrysanthemum Cyclamen Fuchsia Geranium Impatiens Marigold Petunia Primrose Poinsettia Rose Tulip	<b>CONTAINER AND BEDGROWN PLANTS</b> Mix 4 b. of TRUBAN 25% E.C. with 100 gal. of water per 400 sq. ft. or apply amount to saturate the soil mixture, such as 1 pint per 6 sq. ft. immediately with additional water equal to at least half the fungicide drench for improved soil penetration of the fungicide. Repeat at 2 week intervals, if necessary.

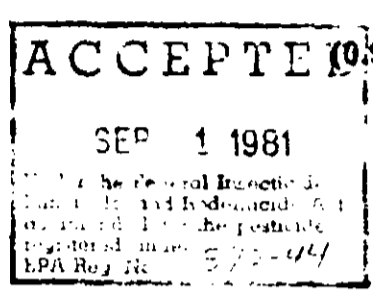
