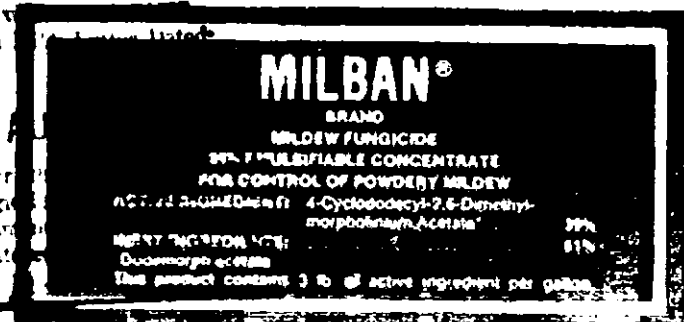

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — Cont'd.

With the sprayer agitator operating, prepare a spray solution of 32 fl. oz. (0.95L) in 100 gal. (378L) of water. Spray to thoroughly cover the foliage. Treat at 10 to 14 day intervals under conditions favorable to powdery mildew. If mildew is already present, treatment should be made at weekly intervals until disease is under control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store at temperatures above 32°F (0°C)

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then recycle where available, or landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.
