 Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, stockpile waste storage and enclosed processing systems (milk, dairies, ad-bis-ox, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation also would be considered a food area).

Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using burrow duster or other suitable equipment capable of applying insecticide directly into cracks and crevices in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, where cockroaches and ants hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.
