Your Submission Dated December 17, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Delete the wording, "Resistant and Non-Resistant Cockroaches." If you wish to use this wording you must specify the insecticides involved in the claimed resistance.
  - b. The signal words "POISON DANGER" and the skull and crossbones must be printed in red.
  - c. The Statement of Practical Treatment and Note to Physician (front panel) must be revised. We suggest the following; however, if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control  
Center immediately. If possible,

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medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, nonreactive pinpoint pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps.

[Note - you may choose to expand the Note to Physician (above) by adding the items "Morphine is contraindicated" through ". . . as determined by blood test," from the submitted left panel Treatment section.]

- d. Your Storage and Disposal section needs to be revised according to PR Notice 83-3 (a copy is enclosed).
- e. Under your Directions for Use section, delete the last paragraph, "This product is toxic to fish . . . ."
- f. Under the Precautionary Statements section delete the Environmental Hazards section. Your product is for indoor use. Only products for outdoor use are required to make statements relative to environmental hazards.
- g. The last sentence under Precautionary Statements needs to be revised to read, "Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health, under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11."

- h. Delete the subheading "Note to Physician" under the Precautionary Statements section. It will appear in its correct location under the Statement of Practical Treatment (item c above).
  - i. The paragraphs below the Precautionary Statements blocking, starting with the wording, "Decontaminate and Destroy . . ." (small print), should be deleted.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
