

PETTIT YACHT COPPER PAINT

This famous brand of copper paint has been on the market for many years. This paint is manufactured for use on the bottoms of wooden boats for protection against barnacles, teredo worms and other marine growths. Do not use on any type of metal boat bottom.

DIRECTIONS

Stir the copper paint thoroughly and apply two coats, allowing the first coat to dry overnight before applying the second coat. Keep the paint stirred while in use. The bottom to be painted should be as dry as practical. The old paint should be scrubbed or scraped off as thoroughly as possible. On bare wood first apply one coat of PETTIT'S RED LEAD PRIMER.

The boat should be launched within 48 hours after the second coat is applied.

PETTIT OLD SALEM COPPER BRONZE COMPOSITION

ANTI-FOULING TYPE

This product is a very effective anti-fouling yacht bottom paint. It is easy to apply and dries quickly to a smooth hard finish. Due to its extreme fineness and hard surface finish it is particularly recommended for racing craft. For best results the old bottom paint should be cleaned to the bare wood. Then apply one coat of PETTIT'S RED LEAD, thinned, if necessary with PETTIT'S #120 BRUSHING THINNER and allow to dry thoroughly hard. Next apply at least two coats of OLD SALEM COPPER BRONZE COMPOSITION without the addition of any thinners. Care should be taken to stir thoroughly before applying and during application. If the COPPER BRONZE should become too heavy, use Denatured Alcohol for thinning as well as cleaning brushes. Allow final coat to dry hard before launching.
