This is a plastic type of strong anti-fouling paint which incorporates the latest research developments in the marine field.

SUPER TROPICOP RED may be used on either steel or wooden boats to provide positive protection against barnacles, toredo worms and other marine growth.

DIRECTIONS

The bottom to be painted should be dry and the old paint thoroughly cleaned. Old paint in poor condition should be removed.

Stir the paint thoroughly at first and then occasionally during application.

Allow at least six hours drying time between coats and after the final coat before launching.

WOODEN HULLS: Prime all bare wood with PETTIT's RED LEAD PRIMER and dry overnight. Sand lightly. Apply two coats of SUPER TROPICOP RED. On repaint work, always apply two coats of SUPER TROPICOP.

STEEL HULLS: Remove all rust, grease and scale from the metal surface. Apply one coat of PETTIT's METAL PRIMER to bare metal. Follow with two coats of PETTIT's ZINC CHROMATE PRIMER or PETTIT's VINYL RED UNDERCOATER. Finally, apply two coats of SUPER TROPICOP RED.

Use PETTIT's #120 BRUSHING THINNER for thinning, if necessary, and for cleaning brushes.
