ACTIVE INGREDIENTS; Isopropyl alcohol, Methyl dodecyl benzyl trimethyl ammonium chloride,  
"Methyl dodecyl xylene bis (trimethyl) ammonium chloride", Technical  
piperonyl butoxide, pyrethrins.

INERT INGREDIENTS; 62.4% (Water and Octyl phenoxypoly ethoxy ethanol).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE; Using a hand or power sprayer keeping same approximately one foot  
from article to be sprayed, apply "STERI-FAB" over all surfaces  
until thoroughly dampened coverage is obtained. Be sure that all  
folds, creases, seams etc., are also covered in this manner.

MATRESSES; -- varies from 4 to 8 ounces depending on size. Single bed and folding cot  
mattresses use 4 to 5 ounces "STERI-FAB" Double bed mattresses use 6 to  
8 ounces "STERI-FAB"

SOFAS; Small sizes such as love seats, use 4 to 5 ounces "STERI-FAB". Regular size  
sofas, use 6 to 8 ounces. Use 8 ounces "STERI-FAB" on convertible sofas.

UPHOLSTERED CHAIRS; Use 5 to 7 ounces "STERI-FAB".

The above suggested quantities of "STERI-FAB" when used as directed furnishes good  
coverage on these articles providing for sanitizing, bacteriostatic and fungistatic  
values, and insecticidal qualities against bed bugs and roaches.

For the disinfection of non-upholstered chairs, bed springs, furniture (those with  
non porous surfaces) "STERI-FAB" should be applied to all surfaces until a dew like  
appearance is obtained. This will also provide insecticidal qualities against bed  
bugs and roaches.

CAUTION; Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contamination of food. If sprayed in  
eyes, wash eyes with large quantities of water. If irritation persists consult physician.

For control of roaches:

The infested area should be sprayed thoroughly, and repeatedly,

For control of bedbugs:

Mats and mattresses should be sprayed thoroughly, and repeatedly,  
directing spray into all cracks and hiding places, seams, creases and folds.
