Technology Sciences Group Inc. (TSG), on behalf of Noble Pine Products Co. (Noble Pine), is hereby submitting a label notification for EPA Registration Number 397-13, Steri-Fab<sup>®</sup>, to add EPA requested PPE language, correct emergency contact phone number and optional marketing claims.

On October 9, 2012, EPA approved the Steri-Fab® reregistration label with the following language under the **Personal Protective Equipment** section:

- AS AN INSECTICIDE, BACTERICIDE, MOLD AND MILDEWCIDE, DEODORANT AND FUNGICIDE: spray surfaces and articles until thoroughly dampened and allow to remain wet for at least 10 minutes
- TO KILL ROACHES, BEDBUGS, ANTS AND SILVERFISH: The infested areas should be sprayed thoroughly and repeatedly, directing the spray into all crevices, cracks, hiding places, seams, creases and folds.
