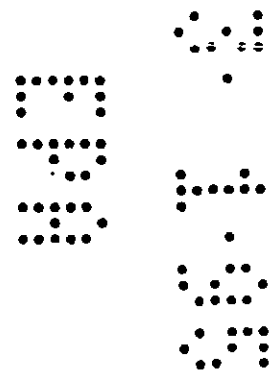

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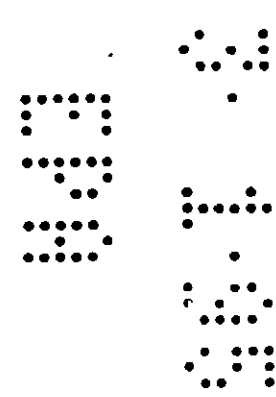
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**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

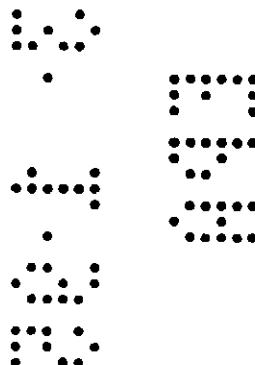
