EPA hereby approves your requests of December 12, 1988 and January 24, 1989 to amend the labels of products containing propargite. We are approving this labeling now since the proposed revisions upgrades the precautionary statements and adds additional user protection statements beyond that which appears on current labeling. This acceptance should not be construed in anyway as signifying the Agency's agreement or determination that the subject label changes demonstrate an acceptable margin of safety to applicators/workers exposed to propargite in light of the benefits of use. As you know the Agency is currently assessing new exposure data and reevaluating existing toxicity data with respect to applicator and field worker safety. After completion of this review the Agency will determine if any regulatory action is warranted.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

- a. The "If On Skin" and "If In Eyes" statements of practical treatment should be listed first under the Statement of Practical Treatment heading.

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
- b. Change If Inhaled Statement to read - If inhaled Remove person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if symptoms indicate. Call a physician.
- c. You must indicate on the labeling (under direction for use) the specific formulating uses you intend to support, i.e., under directions for use add following statement:

"This technical product can be formulated into end-use products for use on:

(Add the uses from page 32 of the Guidance Document on Propargite you intend to support.)
