On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Decision, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Generic data requirements that have been identified in the RED as confirmatory data for the active ingredient contained in the subject product will continue to be tracked and assessed in the Agency's continual reassessment of pesticides.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided you:

1. Change the company name from "Crompton Uniroyal Chemical" to "Chemtura USA Corporation".
2. In the ingredients statement we recommend changing the term "Inert Ingredients" to read "Other Ingredients".
3. Under the heading "Storage and Disposal", change the sub-heading "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage"

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4. Revise the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" statements as follows:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

"Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Causes skin burns. Do not get on eyes or clothing. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco."

5. Revise the "First Aid" and "Note to Physician" Statements as follows:

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx for emergency medical treatment information."

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS: "Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

We recommend adding to this statement a company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice as well as information that can address the primary eye and skin irritation concerns.

6. We recommend adding the following personal protective statements beneath the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" paragraph.

"Wear protective clothing (coveralls worn over long sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, chemical resistant footwear and gloves) and protective eyewear during handling."

7. Revise the Environmental Hazard statements as follows:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

"This product is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates and may cause reproductive effects in wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage without previously notifying the sewage plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

7. Revise the "Directions for Use" to allow reformulation of the product for a specific use.

"Only for formulation into an miticide for the following uses: alfalfa grown for seed; almond; apples (non-bearing); apricots (non-bearing); avocado (non-bearing); bean, dry (including dry lima beans); berries (non-bearing); boysenberry (non-bearing); carrot (grown for seed); cherry (foliar after harvest); Christmas tree, ornamental and/or shade, ornamental herbaceous plants; clover grown for seed; corn (field, pop, sweet); cotton; currant (non-bearing); dates (non-bearing); figs (non-bearing); grapefruit; grapes; hazel nut (non-bearing); hops; jojoba; lemon; lime (non-bearing); macadamia nut (non-bearing); mint (field grown); nectarine; orange; peaches (non-bearing); pears (non-bearing); peanuts; pecan (non-bearing);

persimmon (non-bearing); pistachio (non-bearing); plums (non-bearing); potato; prunes (non-bearing); quince (non-bearing); raspberry (non-bearing); roses(field grown); strawberries (non-bearing); sorghum; sugar beets (grown for seed); tangerines (non-bearing); and walnuts.

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8. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 10, 2003 is acceptable and is the CSF of record superseding all previous CSFs.

You may distribute products bearing old labels/labeling for 12 months from receipt of this letter or your next printing of the label, which ever occurs first. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
