- 1. Per the acute toxicity review, the following text must be added to the First Aid statements:
 "IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice."
- 2. Per the acute toxicity review, the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section must be revised to read as follows:

"CAUTION
 Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet."

The one year, room temperature Storage Stability and Corrosion Characteristics studies are still not complete. The remaining 9 and 12-month data are still outstanding.

This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporation the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supersede all previously accepted labels. A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records.
