VITAVAX-17 Flowable Fungicide is a ready-to-use seed treatment.

COTTON

VITAVAX-17 Flowable Fungicide provides systemic control of seed and seedling diseases of cotton. Seed rot, damping off and sore-shin due to *Rhizoctonia solani* are prevented. VITAVAX-17 Flowable Fungicide can be used on both machine and acid delinted cottonseed at the rate of 16 fluid ounces per 100 pounds of seed. VITAVAX-17 Flowable Fungicide should be applied as a slurry treatment by machine.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not use treated cottonseed for food, feed or oil purposes. Do not graze or feed livestock on hay grown from treated seed.

COMPATIBILITY

VITAVAX-17 Flowable Fungicide is designed for use on seed previously treated or to be treated with the recommended rate of other seed treatment fungicides, such as captan or thiram, or seed treatment insecticides such as Disyston or Thimet.

However, VITAVAX-17 Flowable Fungicide should not be directly mixed with fungicides or insecticides prior to application.
