DIRECTIONS FOR USE

VITAVAX-30C Concentrate is for use by professional seed processors only. Observe all cautions and limitations on labeling of all products used in mixtures.

COTTON

VITAVAX-30C Concentrate controls *Rhizoctonia solani* on cotton. For early season plantings in cold soils, use the highest recommended rate per 100 pounds of seed. Under severe planting conditions, use a supplemental EPA approved in-furrow granule to aid in disease control.

Use VITAVAX-30C Concentrate at the rate of 3.3 fluid ounces to 6.6 fluid ounces per 100 pounds of cottonseed.

PEANUTS

Use 3 fluid ounces of VITAVAX-30C Concentrate per 100 pounds of seed as a part of Gustafson's PROIZED Systems. Consult Gustafson's Botran-30C label for complete mixing directions and application instructions.

USE PRECAUTION
