PRECAUTIONS USE

Mixers. lcaders, and applicators, when mixing, loading, and applying, must wear mid-forearm to elbow-length natural or synthetic rubber, vinyl, or plastic gloves impermeable to captan: boots or overshoes: one-piece overalls which have long sleeves and long pants: face shield or coggles and a hat or other appropriate head covering.

Fieldworkers and harvesters must wear natural or synthetic rubbet. vinyl, or plastic gloves impermeable to captan residues. Leather or fabric gloves are not acceptable.

A dust mask must be worn when mixing and loading his product.

RECOMMENDATIONS

DE-PESTER SOYBEAN SEED PROTECTANT is especially formulated for treatment of soybean seed for the control of seed and soil-borne diseases, including damping-off and seed decay arganisms, and seedling blights, and is prepared for use directly in the planter box, thereby eliminating additional seed handling to have seed treated. This material provides adequate coverage of seed and any excess flows with the seed into the furrow, giving additional protection against sail-borne diseases.

Do not use treated seed for food, feed or oil purposes.

Use DE-PESTER SOYBEAN SEED PROTECTANT at the rate of 4 oz. per bu, or 7 oz. per 100 lb, of seed as a planter box treatment. May be used an previously treated seed.
