STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and separately launder clothing before reuse.

Mixers/loaders when mixing and loading this product must wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or a face shield and a chemically resistant apron.

A dust mask must be worn when mixing and loading this product.

During application only, from a tractor with a completely enclosed cab a long sleeved shirt and long legged pants must be worn. Chemically resistant gloves must be available in the cab and worn while exiting.

Fieldworkers and harvesters must wear chemical resistant gloves. Leather or fabric gloves are not acceptable.

AFTER WORK: Take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with captan must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

RECOMMENDATIONS

DE-PESTER SOYBEAN SEED PROTECTANT is especially formulated for treatment of soybean seed for the control of seed and soil-borne diseases, including damping-off and seed decay in the planter box, thereby eliminating additional seed handling to have seed treated. This material provides adequate coverage of seed and any excess flows with the seed into the furrow, giving additional protection against soil-borne disease.

Do not use treated seed for food, feed or oil purposes.

Use DE-PESTER SOYBEAN SEED PROTECTANT at the rate of 4 oz. per bu. or 7 oz. per 100 lbs. of seed as a planter box treatment. May be used on previously treated seed.
