for the control of Southern blight (Southern Stem and Root Rot)-Sclerotium rolfsii; Aphids, Leafhoppers, Mites and Thrips:

ROW (IN-FURROW) TREATMENT: Apply 100 lbs. per acre (1 lb. to 124 linear feet of row) in an 8 to 12 inch band centered on the row and mixed with the soil to a depth of 2 to 4 inches. Application may be made simultaneously with planting, using suitable application equipment. Avoid application techniques which will allow direct contact of the granules with the seed.

SURFACE BAND TREATMENT: This product may be applied at pegging time, as a side-dressing, using 100 lbs. per acre (1 lb. to 124 linear feet of row).

NOTE: Do not exceed 10 lbs actual PCNB per acre in any one season, regardless of the application methods used. Do not feed treated vines to livestock. Do not allow hogging down of peanuts

Do not plant any root crop not registered for PCNB in rotation on PCNB treated soil.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. In the Hazards to Humans text, delete "In case of eye contact, flush with plenty of water." Also in this section add "and before eating or smoking" to "wash thoroughly all exposed skin."
2. Add the following to the environmental hazards "Birds and other wildlife feeding on treated areas may be killed. Cover or incorporate granules which are spilled during loading and which are visible on the soil surface in turn areas."
3. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement; however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.
