The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following comments:

1. The "If On Skin" statement must appear before the other statements of practical treatment.
2. The "If In Eyes" statement must include the sentence "Call a physician if irritation persists".
3. Under the precautionary statements, the sentence "Causes skin irritation" must be changed to "Causes skin and eye irritation".

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your information.

Also, in a previous Agency letter dated September 26, 1988, you were requested to fulfill outstanding data requirements by submitting an Acute Inhalation Toxicity study and a Dermal Sensitization study. You must submit these outstanding studies. Further labeling revisions may be necessary following the submission of outstanding study data.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady stream of water for 15 minutes.

ORNAMENTALS

For bedding and bench plantings use with water as a soil drench at time of seeding and transplanting in commercial nurseries and greenhouses. The drench solution should be continually agitated to assure uniform application of the fungicidal material. To improve penetration of the fungicide, the drenching should be followed with an equal quantity of water applied either by sprinkling or by irrigation
