REENTRY STATEMENT - EXCEPT FOR HARVESTING

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

Do not enter treated areas until sprays have dried.

Protective clothing requirements are outlined below for the indicated reentry. ← (5)

1. Early entry is defined as any worker who is directed to enter a reentry restricted area prior to the expiration of any reentry interval that applies to that area. This will include those activities necessitated by unexpected events such as weather, pest conditions, equipment failure, etc. and does not include routine cultural practices.
2. These workers will wear protective clothing to include at least:
 - a hat or other suitable head covering
 - long-sleeved shirt and long-legged trousers or a coverall type garment (closely woven fabric covering the body including arms and legs).
 - chemical resistant gloves.
 - shoes and socks.
- NOTE: Occupants of enclosed cab vehicles must wear normal work attire.
3. These workers will wear normal work attire to include at least:
 - a hat or other suitable head covering.
 - long-sleeved shirt and long-legged trousers
 - shoes and socks
4. All other activities include those which have high foliar exposure such as pruners, cane turners and tippers (table grapes), etc.
5. See use directions for time of harvest after last application.

Because certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

Written or oral warnings must be given to the workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area to be treated with this product. When oral warnings are given, warnings shall be given in a language customarily understood by workers. Oral warnings must be given if there is reason to believe that written warnings cannot be understood by workers. Written or oral warnings must include the following information:

"DANGER, Area to be treated with Propargite on (date of application). Do not enter without appropriate protective clothing until sprays have dried. Tractor drivers and irrigators and scouts wearing normal work attire may enter after 48 hours. Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing to perform activities that involve substantial or prolonged exposure with treated foliage for (enter number of days)."

If accidentally exposed, consult the Statement of Practical Treatment portion of this label for first aid recommendations.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Mixer/loaders must wear goggles or a face shield, chemical-resistant apron, long-sleeved shirt, long pants, and mid-forearm to elbow length chemical-resistant gloves.

(6) Applicators. If applying more than 10 lbs. of OMITE CR per acre in air-blast equipment must be in an enclosed cab. At rates of 10 lbs. or less and if not in an enclosed cab, applicators must wear goggles, wide brimmed hat, a long-sleeved shirt and long pants, and chemical-resistant gloves while applying this pesticide.

Any article of clothing worn while mixing, loading or applying product must be cleaned before re-use. Clothing should be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing that has been drenched or has otherwise absorbed concentrated pesticide must be disposed of in a sanitary landfill, incinerated, or burned if allowed by State and local authorities.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Do not plant any food or feed crop in rotation within 6 months after last application of propargite unless the crop is a registered use for propargite.

Do not feed livestock on cover crops grown among the trees listed on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE ← (7)

OMITE-CR is a dry wettable powder for preparing sprays to control citrus red and two-spotted spider mites.

OMITE-CR is not systemic in action; therefore complete coverage of both upper and lower leaf surfaces and of fruit is necessary for effective control. Always use at least the minimum recommended amount of OMITE-CR per acre. OMITE-CR can be used in concentrate sprays, but no less than 100 gallons per acre.

(7) (DELETE SPANISH DIRECTIONS)

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

This package contains 2x1½ pound water soluble bags of OMITE-CR. After opening package:

1. Do not open or perforate the inner water soluble bags of OMITE-CR. The water soluble bags and contents will dissolve in water.
2. Immediately dump entire contents into spray tank.
3. Do not touch water soluble bags as handling may cause breakage.
4. Use only entire water soluble bag. Do not break bags or use partial bags. ← (8)
5. Do not begin spraying until the bag is completely dissolved and the powder is thoroughly dispersed in the spray tank.
6. If only one water soluble bag is used, store the remaining bag in the original package in a dry location away from heat or cold.
7. IMPORTANT: Do not use screens finer than 25 mesh in spraying equipment. ← (8)

*Each water soluble bag contains 1½ lbs. of OMITE-CR.

APPLICATION NOTES:

1. OMITE-CR may cause some leaf burn on new growth (feather growth) of lemons.
2. OMITE-CR performance is best when daily temperatures average above 70°F.
3. Second treatment must be made no closer than 42 days after the first.
4. Foliar oil applications must not follow OMITE-CR treatments within 30 days.
5. OMITE-CR when used alone may follow foliar oils at an interval of greater than 40 days after an oil application.
6. Even though there is a 7 day PHI, harvesting cannot take place until the reentry interval expires.

(10) (NOTE FROM "USE NOTE: (10) RESTRICTIONS") OMITE-CR is not compatible with foliar spray oils. (Further information from supplier or Uniroyal).
OMITE-CR is not compatible with alkaline materials such as lime, lime sulfur or Bordeaux. The effectiveness of OMITE-CR will be reduced.

COMPATIBILITIES — Except as noted above OMITE-CR is compatible with many pesticides. (See caution statements). Check with your supplier or Uniroyal for details. Observe all cautions and limitations of labeling of all products used in mixtures.

LABEL REVISIONS

OMITE CR (CA. COLLATERAL LABEL)

1. Front panel
 - assignment of same new EPA Reg. No. as for non-CA labels.
 - add statement that package contains 2, 1-1/2 lb. water soluble bags.
2. Statement of Practical Treatment
 - put statements in priority of tox category.
 - add "Get medical attention after "If on skin" statement.
 - add "Do not induce vomiting" to "If Swallowed statement.
 - delete "Avoid exposure to dust" (under precautionary statements)
3. Precautionary Statements
 - change the word "vapors" to "dust".
4. Storage and Disposal
 - change to read "Place water soluble bag directly into application equipment (see directions). Then dispose of empty outer bag....". Current disposal statement is inappropriate for a water soluble bag product.
5. Re-entry
 - remove "without protective clothing". This statement conflicted with re-entry directions which follow. Uniroyal does not wish any re-entry until sprays have dried.
6. Use restrictions
 - add "mixing, loading or". This statement extends cleaning of clothing to those engaged in these tasks.
7. Directions for Use (was "General Instructions").
 - delete Spanish directions. The same statement appears in bold type on the front panel.
8. Mixing instructions
 - add screen restriction to prevent clogging.
 - add sentence "Use entire water soluble bag. Do not break bags or use partial bags".
9. Dosage instructions
 - indicate use rate in number of lbs. not in number of bags per acre to prevent grower confusion.
 - add footnote to inform user of the pounds of formulated product in each bag.
10. Application notes
 - change the word "Caution" to "note" in order to remove conflict with signal word on front panel.
 - add two application notes to bring label into conformity with other propargite labels.
