- 2. Make the label changes that are listed below before you release the product for shipment:

  - b. Under First Aid, list the "If on skin or clothing" statements first.

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c. Revise the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section to read exactly as follows:

"May be fatal if absorbed through skin. Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, chemical-resistant footwear, and chemical-resistant gloves. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear protective eyewear."

- d. Under Environmental Hazards, revise the first sentence by replacing "unless this product is...permit" with "unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge" (Pesticide Regulation Notice 93-10).
- e. Revise the Pesticide Disposal statements to read:
  "Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility."
- f. In the sentence following "FORMULATION ASSISTANCE:" on the second page, change "regaring" to "regarding".
- 3. The product chemistry data requirement for the discussion of formation of impurities (40 CFR 158.167) is not satisfied. The required data must be submitted to the Agency within 90 days following the date of this letter. Refer to enclosed Product Chemistry review memo for details.
- 4. Satisfy the data requirements for Storage Stability (requirement 830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristics (requirement 80.6320). Data intended to satisfy these requirements have been submitted and are in review at this time.

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5. Submit one copy of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
