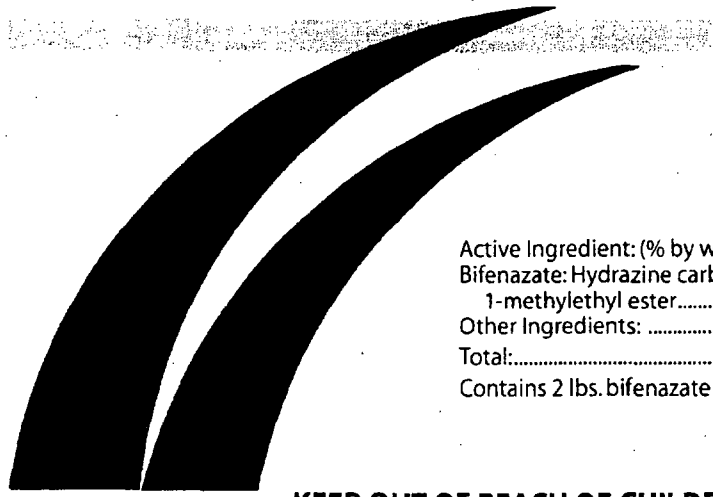

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Keep unprotected persons and pets out of treated areas until sprays have dried.

KILLS:

a variety of mites species, especially spider mites, red mites and grass mites. It is not effective against rust mites, broad mites and flat mites. FLORAMITE H&G is primarily active on the motile stages of mites, but also has activity against spider mite eggs.

WHERE TO USE:

- All ornamental plants, including bedding plants, flowering plants, foliage plants, bulb crops, perennials, trees and shrubs.
- All non-bearing fruit trees which will not bear fruit for a minimum of 12 months.

Do not apply to fruits or vegetables used for food.

HOW MUCH TO USE:

Mix $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons per gallon of water and apply as a full coverage spray to the foliage.

This product can be applied with all types of hand sprayers. Read and carefully follow the instructions for the type of sprayer you use.

WHEN TO USE:

Apply as soon as mites appear. An application can be made every 30 days.

FLORAMITE H&G is not systemic in action; therefore complete coverage of both upper and lower leaf surfaces is necessary for effective control.

IMPORTANT

Neither the manufacturer nor the seller has determined whether or not FLORAMITE H&G can be used safely on all ornamental plants. FLORAMITE H&G has been tested on a variety of ornamental plants with no phytotoxicity observed at label rates.
